

Sandy Burr Inner Club Season Opening Meeting Minutes
April 8, 2018
Sandy Burr Country Club, Wayland, MA

Bruce Cavella, Executive Board President, calls the meeting to order, welcomes the membership, and makes special mention of the new members in attendance.

The President gives an update on golf course conditions and tee marker changes. The green and forward tees have been moved on hole numbers 1, 6 and 18. Member handicaps are active and the official score recording season is April 1 to November 30.

The President introduces the Executive Board, including 2018 Members At-Large John Carrington and Sean Quinlan. All contact information can be found online at www.sbicgolf.com.

Vice President, Darlene Rogers, updates membership that all Inner Club communication will be via email- check your promotions/junk folder if you are not receiving emails.

Dave Aucoin, Tournament Chairman, distributes the 2018 schedule and introduces the Tournament Committee. The Committee: Steve Clancy, Alan Finkelstein, Jacob Friedman, Terry Goss, Arnie Nadeau, Sean Quinlan, Jim Saulnier, Ken Stone, Jim Travers Jr., Peter Vigliano.

The Tournament Chairman highlights three bonus days on the Tournament schedule. The added bonuses (or incentives) will be decided on the day of the tournaments. Two mystery tournaments are also on the schedule. These will be either 2-person or 4-person tournaments depending on the number of participants. Additionally, 2-man combined points tournaments will be blind draws.

The Tournament Chairman explains the Tournament sign-up policy. Sign-up sheets are located on the porch for the following weekend. The deadline to sign-up is 12pm Sunday. This deadline is final. Emails to the Tournament Chairman will only be accepted before 12pm on the Sunday before the tournament (same as signing up in person). Anyone emailing after the 12pm deadline, can expect to be offered an alternate (not guaranteed) spot in the field and only if they are available.

Tee selection process is addressed: Men will play from the blue or white tees, women play the red/forward tees, and men 70-years and older have the option to play from the green tees. You must declare the tee you will be playing before May 28, 2018. You may change tees one time before May 28. It is the responsibility of each member to clearly state which set of tees they will be competing from and then play from those tees every round.

The President informs the membership about a potential re-rating of the golf course this summer by Sandy Burr. The Inner Club will also discuss re-rating the green and forward tees as more data is gathered during the golf season.

The Opening meeting is adjourned by the President.
